Class Rules

Classroom Procedures

Journal:

Homework:

All assignments are due at the beginning of the period. If it's not complete when the bell rings, it is considered late, and points will be deducted. If the homework will be submitted online, it needs to be submitted before the deadline and the assignment closes. **For online assignments they are due regardless of whether or not you are absent.**

Participation:

Engagement and participation is required. If you are on time and participating on a daily basis, you will receive full points. If you are constantly interrupting and not participating effectively and not coming to class prepared, you will lose some of your participation points.

Bathroom/Leaving Class Procedures:

If you need to leave class, please follow it in a responsible manner. You are not required to raise your hand and ask to leave, but if you abuse this privilege, your participation grade will be affected.
